- * Connect the electrodes to a 6V battery.
- * Fill the mug with water such that the electrodes are immersed. Add a few drops of dil.sulphuric acid.
- * take two test tubes filled with water and invert them over the two carbon electrodes.
- * Switch on the current and leave for some time.
